- A. The Fall Sprints Regional Road Races, October 18-19, 2008 at Blackhawk Farms Raceway, Rockton, IL.
- B. Regional Sanction No: 08-R-345-S
- C. This event is organized by the Chicago Region, Sports Car Club of America, Inc., (SCCA), and will be held under the current SCCA General Competition Rules (GCR) and official updates, except as modified by these Supplemental Regulations.

These races are open to all SCCA Novice Permit holders who have satisfied the school requirements, to current holders of SCCA Regional or National licenses, and to SCCA members who hold other recognized licenses, per the GCR and current Fastrack. See official schedule for race grouping and session lengths.

- 3. Entries are not official until the entry form is signed/submitted online, received, paid, and accepted. We are not responsible for entries lost or delayed in transit, unreadable faxes, failed faxes, or failed emails. Telephone entries will not be accepted. Faxed and e-mail entries without a valid credit card number will not be processed. Late fees may be applied in these cases. A \$40.00 service fee will be charged for bad/returned/NSF checks and/or refused credit card charges, and the entry will also be considered a late entry. Personal checks, cash, cashiers checks, traveler's checks, and Visa/MasterCard will be accepted.
  - 4. Requests for refund must be made in writing to the Registrar no later than 10 days after the event, Requests for refund beyond 10 days after the event must be made in writing to the Chicago Region Competition Committee. A \$25.00 cancellation fee applies to all cancellations.

  - I. Race results and trophy distribution will be per the GCR and FasTrack updates. They will be available at Driver Information Center after results become official. No trophies will be mailed

K. Other information

1. In accordance with Central Division regulations, **all cars in FF, CFF, FV, FS, FST, and F5 must be presented for full GCR re-inspection per GCR 5.9.2.C.** Tech stickers will not be issued for these cars until they complete this re-inspection.
2. The sound limit for this event is 102dB. During the race you will be black flagged after 3 readings in excess of 102dB, and moved to last finishing position if you have a finish with a loss of event points.
3. Functioning AMB TRANX 260 transponders properly mounted to the competition vehicle will be required for all classes. Transponder times are official time for all race groups.
4. The below radio frequencies are reserved for race operations and may not be used by competitors. Race officials reserve the right to designate other frequencies for race administration.

5. If the fastest qualifier in a race group chooses to start from the "outside pole position" (per GCR), this decision must be conveyed to the Grid Marshal at the front of the field *before* the 5 minute signal is given for that race group.
6. Split starts will be at the discretion of the Chief Steward. The Chief Steward must receive a petition within one hour of posting of the final grid.
7. When entering the track from the pits, drivers must keep their cars to the right of the blend line up to corner 1. When leaving the pits, scrubbing of tires is not permitted until past the apex of corner 1.
8. Drivers may be held responsible for damages to property, including track and environmental damage.
9. CenDiv Championship Series decals are required to be displayed on both sides of all cars.
10. ITE1, ITE2, SPO, SPU, CFF, and CFC car specifications are per CenDiv Championship Series rules. SM and SMT tires are per CenDiv Championship Series rules. Contact the Chief of Tech to confirm eligibility.
11. Formula First (**FST**) – Formula Vee cars that have been upgraded and modified in accordance with the Formula First rules, available at [www.formula-first.org](http://www.formula-first.org).
12. Attached are the Blackhawk Farms track rules. They are considered part of these supplementary regulations, and are enforceable as such. Special Fall Sprints Regional amendments to these rules:
  - i. On track hours will be per schedule and/or adjusted as needed for race operations.
  - ii. No race engines may be run past 15 minutes after the last checkered flag of each day or the time published in the track rules, whichever is later. Cars that are released from impound or SOMs after that point may restart their engine, and drive directly to their paddock (unless otherwise directed), and shut off their engine for the day.
  - iii. All competitors must vacate the premises by 7:00PM Sunday.

Blackhawk Farms Raceway  
2008 Track Rules

1. NOISE POLLUTION REGULATION: No race car or engine, including showroom cars with open exhaust, shall be run before 8:00AM or after 6:00PM on any weekend day or not before 9:00AM or after 4:30PM on weekdays.
2. A pass indicating you have registered for the event must be presented to the Guard to allow your entry onto the property of Blackhawk Farms Raceway.
3. All minors must be under direct parental or acting guardian supervision at all times.
4. Drivers are responsible for the conduct of their crews and guests.
5. ALL PETS must be leashed or confined.
6. No two or three wheeled vehicles are allowed except for race officials' use or as race support vehicles. Only licensed drivers 16 and above may operate race support vehicles or golf carts.
7. Our concession stand will be available for most events. Gas, oil, water, and air are available. Souvenirs, film, and other consumables are available in Corner 10. Coin operated showers are also available.
8. ALL TRASH MUST be placed in receptacles provided. Environmentally hazardous waste MUST be disposed of in appropriate receptacles. All used tires MUST be removed or the organization will be charged for their disposal.
9. All drivers and members will be responsible for notifying crew and guests concerning the hours of registration.
10. Electric power is available. Tags for the outlets will be issued at time of plug-in and payment arrangements can be made either with security or in Corner 10.
11. All drivers, members, officials, and spectators must comply with the Pit Vehicle Policy of BFR; including the purchase and display for a Pit Vehicle Pass for each unit present on the premises.

**Fall Sprints  
Information Sheet**

- A. All qualifying times, grids, results, and sound readings will be posted at the Driver Information Center located in the pavilion.
- B. These races are part of the CenDiv Championship Series, and shall be conducted under series rules found at [http://www.scca-chicago.com/roadracing/2008\\_tro\\_championship.html](http://www.scca-chicago.com/roadracing/2008_tro_championship.html)
- C. No radio-controlled devices may be operated from 8:00AM to 6:30PM.
- D. Skateboards, roller blades and roller skates, motorized skateboards, and non-motorized scooters are prohibited.
- E. Pace/Safety cars may be used at this event.
- F. Results will be available at <http://www.scca-chicago.com> as soon as possible after the event.
- G. In the event a yellow flag is required for pit lane only, a yellow flag with a board reading "PIT LANE" will be displayed at corner 6A. A "PITS CLOSED" sign will be displayed at the same location if the pit lane is totally blocked.
- H. Only one passenger will be permitted in the race car on the victory lap (passenger must be fully inside car).
- I. Make all checks payable to Chicago Region SCCA, Inc. Entries will NOT be processed without a payment. Faxed copies of checks are NOT acceptable.
- J. The Competition Committee of the Chicago Region, SCCA, Inc. will accept or reject all entries. An entry will not be accepted unless the full entry fee accompanies the entry form. Requests for refunds after the notification date above must be made in writing to the Chief Registrar no later than 10 days after the event. A \$25.00 cancellation fee applies to all cancellations.
- K. Credentials for one driver and up to three (3) crew members will be issued at registration. Three additional crew passes and extra guest passes may be purchased for \$10.00 each. Up to six (6) crew members are allowed in the pits at one time. There is no charge for guest passes for minors 12 and under.
- L. License confirmation: Competitors whose licenses are in process at the time they wish to race must obtain confirmation that their license is valid by arranging with the Registrar to telephone the National Office in Topeka. Per GCR 4.4.9, the National Office has imposed a prepaid fee of \$125 for all special handling of license verifications.
- M. At the time of registration, you must present the following:
  - Current SCCA membership card or proof of membership.
  - SCCA Photo ID. Photo ID's will be available for a nominal fee.
  - For the regional race, valid (signed off) SCCA Novice Permit, or accepted license per GCR.
